This allows them to properly staff the drive, and scheduling helps prevent the delays that can occur when several people show up at the same time. Kroger & Thornton Cards

The AIE Scholarship Foundation sponsors the sale of Kroger and Thornton cards as a means of raising funds for the Foundation.

The cards are available for sale in the school office. The Kroger cards are pre-charged with \$25 and the Thornton cards are pre-charged with \$10. The cards are used like gift cards at the time of the sale.

At any point, the cards can be charged with additional money and used repeatedly for purchases at either Kroger or Thornton. The Foundation receives a percentage of each dollar charged to a card. (Kroger – 5%, Thornton's – 4%) The use of these cards has raised several hundred dollars each month for the Foundation without any additional money spent by the participating family.
