School Choice

School Choice Scholarship applications are now available in the school office. The deadline for turning in the application to the Academy is April 20th. School Choice (not affiliated with the AIE Scholarship Foundation) is a private organization that provides tuition assistance to children grades K-6th. The scholarship is based on financial need and is designed to help parents have choice in their child's education based on preference and quality, not just financial ability.
