Swine Flu Shots

Many of you may have seen in the news where the health department is offering swine flu shots to students at public, parochial and private schools. However, the shots are being made available to children in that order; first public and parochial then private. AIE is currently on the waiting list to receive swine flu shots, however, at this point, there is no guarantee that the vaccine will be available to us. Should an opening become available, we will send information regarding the vaccine and consent forms home at that time. We hope this information helps as you make plans for your family's health.

AIE follows Jefferson County Public Schools to determine closing the school for inclement weather. If Jefferson County closes for snow, AIE will close also. AIE will report the closing to the major television stations; Academy for Individual Excellence will be listed in the closings. However, if the Academy

name fails to show, please check the status of Jefferson County Public Schools.

If there is an opening delay due to weather, the Academy will open on schedule. Please bring your children to school as safe travel permits. If JCPS schools close early, we will close early to allow our families and teachers an opportunity to get home safely. We realize that several of our families come from outlying areas that may be treacherous during bad weather so please only travel as safety permits.
