School Choice Scholarship applications are now available in the school office. The deadline for turning in the application to the Academy is April 16<sup>th</sup>. School Choice (not affiliated with the AIE Scholarship Foundation) is a private organization that provides tuition assistance to children grades K-6<sup>th</sup>. The scholarship is based on financial need and is designed to help parents have a choice in their child's education based on preference and quality, not just financial ability.
